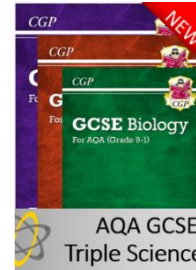
The Plan for Year 11 in Science Lessons

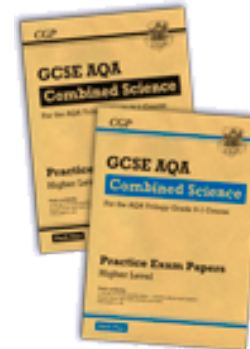

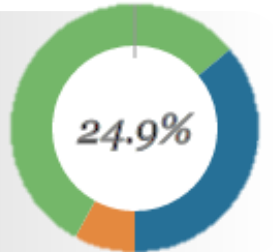

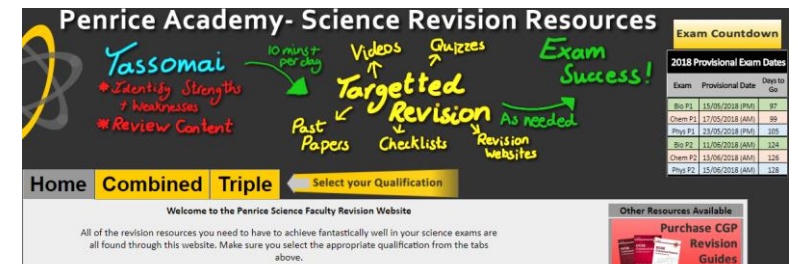
